Ultimately, it's primarily about the customers being able to work well. And if there are problems - whether this involves the air conditioning, the acoustics or definitely in the case of IT - this instantly becomes a sensitive issue. A poor review gets around quickly, so everything has to work perfectly: everyone wants to be able to go online quickly and easily, and work securely. Cheops plays an important role in this.
